## Our Lady of Mt. Carmel and the Brown Scapular

July 16<sup>th</sup> is the memorial of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel (Carmel in Hebrew means "Garden of God"). This feast day is dated through pious tradition as the day in the 13<sup>th</sup> century, that Our Lady of Mt. Carmel gave the brown scapular to St. Simon Stock, a Carmelite priest serving in England. St. Simon was exhorted by Our Lady to make available this scapular to the faithful.

Our Lady of Mt. Carmel will extend her patronage to the faithful who wear the scapular, especially at one's hour of death. The faithful in turn pledge:

- --Devotion to Our Lady and the teachings of the Church,
- --To live a chaste life according to one's station in life
- --And to say the rosary daily or
- --Recite daily the Little Office of the BVM.
- --Observe the fasts of Church with abstinence from meat on Fridays.

One must be vested by a priest or deacon with the accompanying prayers.

For those interested, the vesting of the brown scapular of the Carmelites will be available after the Masses **NEXT weekend**. For those that currently wear the scapular, one's vesture could be renewed.

The Sacrament of Reconciliation will be celebrated 8:30-9:15AM in the lower church NEXT Saturday, July 13.

# St. John the Evangelist Pro-Life Initiative The Supreme Court Rejects Challenge to FDA's Abortion Pill Deregulation

"The plaintiffs have sincere legal, moral, ideological, and policy objections to elective abortion and to FDA's relaxed regulation of mifepristone," Judge Kavanaugh acknowledged in his opinion for the court. He concluded however that, "the federal courts are the wrong forum for addressing the plaintiffs' concerns about FDA's actions." Senior Counsel Erin Hawley, who argued the case before the court on behalf of the pro-life plaintiffs in late March, issued a statement saying, "We are disappointed that the Supreme Court did not reach the merits of the FDA's lawless removal of common sense safety standards for abortion drugs...Nothing in today's decision changes the fact that the FDA's own label says that roughly one in 25 women who take chemical abortion drugs will end up in the emergency room—a dangerous reality the doctors and medical associations we represent in this case know all too well."

#### CROSS ROADS

Ezekiel 2: 2-5; Psalm 123: 1-4; 2Corinthians 12: 7-10; Mark 6: 1-6

The Lord spoke to Ezekiel, and the Holy Spirit entered Ezekiel and set him on his feet. The Lord was sending Ezekiel to the Israelites to warn them about their obstinate hearts, and their rebelliousness. That task may have seemed to Ezekiel to be uncomfortable and possibly dangerous. But there also must have been some consolation when the Lord told Ezekiel that whether the Israelites heeded or resisted him, they would know that a prophet had been among them. As we know, prophets often were not received well. Their primary task was to tell the truth about the behavior of the people when contrary to Lord's will. It often made the people uncomfortable, and sometimes angry. Set in their ways, they did not want to change.

Observing today's world, including the United States, we can conclude that much of humanity has not changed regarding its inclination to resist the will of the Lord. So many people, including some religious leaders in the Church, resist the promptings of the Spirit, Humanity tends to avoid any kind of discomfort, sacrifice, suffering, hardships, constraints, and the truth that we are weak and powerless without the grace of God. Such tendencies seem to be even more prominent in today's world: replacing God with the secular gods of government, amorality, and the gods of I, ME, MY! Much of humanity rejects the notion that St. Paul expressed: that power is perfected in weakness when we admit that we need Christ dwelling within us. Much of humanity asks, "Where is God when we need Him?" The answer is that God is with us always; but much of humanity has turned its back on Him.

In today's gospel, Jesus taught in the synagogue of his own hometown of Nazareth. The people were astonished. They rejected Christ and his teachings. They already had him characterized as just the carpenter's son. To them, Jesus did not meet **their** expectation of what the Messiah would be. Jesus was amazed at their lack of faith. Their thoughts and ways were not God's thoughts and ways. And that is what we are experiencing today all over the world. Humanity must be open to the Lord and the truth about how much we need Him. Comfort can be a good thing from time to time. But it should not be a way of life!
