The Pope Appoints Providence Bishop Richard G. Henning As Archbishop of Boston

The Most Rev. Richard G. Henning will succeed Cardinal Sean O'Malley, who turned 80 on June 29th, as the new Archbishop of Boston and Metropolitan of the Province of Boston, which encompasses seven dioceses in four New England states: Massachusetts, New Hampshire, Maine and Vermont. Bishop Henning, 59, was ordained a priest of the Diocese of Rockville Center in Long Island and has been the ordinary of Providence, RI, for the last year and a half. We offer our prayers and a heart-felt welcome to Archbishop-elect Richard Henning, who will be formally installed on October 31st, at the Cathedral of the Holy Cross in the South End.

Eucharist Adoration on Tuesday Mornings

With the conclusion of the National Eucharistic Congress in Indianapolis, the first such congress in this country since before WWII, there was a prayerful encouragement that the worship and adoration of Our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, through His real presence in the Holy Eucharist, Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity, be further encouraged in parishes. In that in mind, St. John's, in addition to Friday mornings, will also have Eucharistic Adoration on Tuesday mornings following Mass until about 11:30AM.

CROSS ROADS



1 Kings 19: 4-8; Psalm 34: 2-9; Ephesians 4: 30---5: 2; John 6: 41-51

Last week we read about the journey of the Israelites through the desert, and their many challenges, hardships, and dangers. Today's first reading is about the journey of Elijah in the desert on his way to Horeb. But his journey was not an ordinary journey. Elijah was running for his life. Elijah had recently ordered the seizure of the prophets of the false god, Baal. Then Elijah slaughtered all of them by way of the sword. When Jezebel heard of this, she vowed to do the same to Elijah. After some time in the desert, Elijah found a place to rest, prayed to the Lord to take his life, and fell asleep. But the Lord provided a hearth cake and water, and the Angel of the LORD woke Elijah and ordered him to eat. The angel came a second time and ordered Elijah to eat and drink more. The Lord had provided Elijah with what he needed to be strong enough to finish his journey, to walk for forty days and forty nights to Mt. Horab, the mountain of the LORD.

Today's psalm speaks to the reality that if one seeks the Lord, he will help you. The Lord hears the cry of the afflicted and saves them from their distress and fear. He gives all of us the opportunity to taste and see how good the Lord is. Saint Paul reminds us in Ephesians, that to truly hear the Lord and His promptings we must imitate Him, who is love itself. We must not grieve the Spirit of the LORD with the malice that is part of our fallen nature. "All bitterness, fury, anger, shouting, and reviling must be removed from you, along with malice." We must replace those traits with kindness, compassion, and forgiveness if we are to imitate our creator to whom we belong.

Likewise, in John's gospel the LORD, in the person of Jesus Christ, speaks of himself as "...the bread that came down from heaven." He told the murmuring crown of his hometown, "Everyone who listens to my Father and learns from him comes to me...I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world." Listen to the LORD. Imitate the LORD. Compassionately love and help one another. We all have an arduous journey through what, in these times, is a dark and dangerous desert, often devoid of honor, truth, kindness, compassion, and forgiveness. But the LORD hears our cries. When we follow HIS WAY AND HIS WILL, nourishes us, relieves us of our anxiety, distress and fears. Take refuge in **HIM** to whom we belong. He will guide us to eternity with him in heaven.


