## **CROSS ROADS**

Acts 2:1-11/ Psalm 104:1, 24, 29-30, 31,34/ 1Corinthians 12:3-7, 12-13/ Romans 8:8-17/ John 20:19-23 or John 14:15-16, 23-26

Today we celebrate the birth of the New Jerusalem, the Church, which is the Mystical Body of Christ. Before Christ ascended into heaven, he promised that the Holy Spirit would be sent to the disciples. Recall that when Jesus first appeared to the disciples in the locked upper room, on the day of his resurrection, he said "peace be with you", and breathing on them he said "receive the Holy Spirit, as the Father sent me, I send you. His gift of the Holy Spirit then was to give them peace, and to fortify them while waiting for Pentecost. When it was time: the noise like that of a strong wind filled the house and the Holy Spirit descended upon the disciples in the form of tongues of fire. It was astonishing to them and to the many people from that area and from other parts of the Roman Empire, when the disciples began to speak in all the different languages of the people who had gathered in Jerusalem. They were sent, and filled with the Holy Spirit, they preached the good news of redemption and the love of God. Fortified by the Holy Spirit, they would persevere in the face of persecution and suffering.

To paraphrase what the Church emphasizes about Pentecost and today's readings, "All of us have been baptized into one and the same Spirit and live by that same Spirit. That Spirit, the Advocate was given as a gift to the disciples to remind them of all that Jesus said and did, and to strengthen them to go forth in the name of the Lord to renew the face of the earth." Saint Paul reminds us that we must live in the Spirit, not in the flesh. Living in the Spirit is to accept a life that is grounded in the gifts of the Holy Spirit: wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude, knowledge, piety, and fear of the Lord (that overwhelming respect and awe of the glory and power of God". It also is to accept a life grounded in the fruits of the Holy Spirit: charity, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, generosity, gentleness, faithfulness, modesty, self-control, and chastity.

Let us pray: "Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of Your faithful and enkindle in them the fire of Your love... and renew the face of the earth."


